Whether you're on the hunt for an authentic Western experience, a thrilling horseback ride on the open prairie, a quiet hike or meditative day of fishing, or a simple retreat from the frantic pace of life, Oklahoma offers some of the finest hospitality west of the Mississippi.

Guest ranches offer the chance to revel in the romance of frontier times, but both country stays and guest ranches give visitors a chance to catch their breath, watch clouds race across the sky, or take a leisurely stroll under a night sky filled with shimmering stars.
